### **Eligibility**

Applicants must be a graduating senior majoring or minoring in Psychology, as well as majoring or minoring in Art or Art History. Applicants can be a double major, major-minor, or double minor combination.

Applicants must submit an essay, no longer than 500 words, describing their interests in art and psychology. What sparked your interest? Where will your studies lead you? The essay should be typed and double-spaced.

Applicants must contact a faculty member from the Department of Art and Art History as soon as possible to sponsor their application. The professor should be someone who knows the student's work and can provide guidance in the application process. Please provide a copy of your paper to them in time to allow them to read and approve the paper before the deadline.

Please attach a copy of your essay to this signed form. No submissions will be accepted without the approval and signature of a faculty member on the application form.

### **Judging & Ceremony**

In selecting the winner, the faculty will take into consideration the applicant's essay and academic record in the two disciplines. The recipient will be honored at the Misty Dailey Awards Ceremony on Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2016, where they will be presented with a cash award and certificate. A reception for the winners and the Senior Studio Majors' Exhibition will follow in the Walsh Lobby. The recipient is also invited to a formal dinner with the Dailey family following the reception. The recipient will be notified in advance of the event.
